

On the way to Zenda we took a detour to Anthony where we were given a tour of the Harper County Court House and the Old clock. Very interesting.


There was free time to shop, kick tires or visit the Anthony Historical Museum before leaving for Zenda. This could be the subject of another tour.

FORD SCRIPT TRADEMARK

The Ford Script Logo was used as early as 1895 by **Henry Ford** and appeared on vehicles as early as 1904. Early on, the popular legend was that it duplicated **Henry's** flowing signature. Much later researchers found that the script was created by an early employee, **C. Harold Willis** who dug out and old rubber stamp for printing cards and arranged the removable rubber letters to spell "Ford" in that familiar script. Old **Henry** liked it and it has been used ever since, minus 32 years from '50 till '82.

Originally the script was stamped in the brass and later steel radiator shells on the Model T. The familiar blue oval emblem first appeared on the '28 Model A radiator shell and continued till '31, when the blue cloisonné back ground was de-

leted in favor of a full stainless steel emblem. The blue emblem was revived in '32 and continued through '38. In'39 the company went back to the plain script, usually cast in chrome plated pot metal, and continued through '48. With the introduction of the all new '49 Ford the script was totally abandoned in favor of block letters. The following year a, coat of arms, crest was introduced. It wasn't until late '82 that the blue emblem was brought back, with slight dimensional changes and darker blue back ground it remains today.

Coca Cola is consistently claimed to be the most recognizable trademark in the world. It dates back to 1886 and the script is very similar to the Ford script. Perhaps it came from a rubber stamp set also?? **RG**




