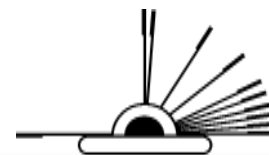

## Model "A"cessories Flying Radiators?

Most Model A's you see today have one of just several radiator caps. Usually a quail, or a moto-meter, (both accessories, not factory equipment by the way) or just a plain cap. And often with the moto-meter, you will find a pair of wings underneath. But in the Model A years, there was a wide choice of "flying" radiator caps to accessorize your ride! In fact there were so many, that for this article, I narrowed it down to just flying things. And then narrowed it down again to just "Wings" and "Propellers". One day in another article, I'll have to do "Birds" as I was surprised at the number of different ones available!

**Motor Wings**



A beautiful ornament that will improve the appearance of any car. This is one of the most popular radiator ornaments on the market. Made of brass, heavily nickel plated so it will not rust. Just the thing to help "dell up" your car. Fastens between Moto-Meter and radiator cap. Prices quoted do not include Moto-Meter or radiator cap. Shipping weight, 1 lb.





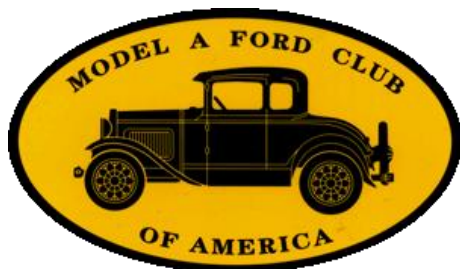
