Tech Talk



Flywheel Housing, Report #2

Last month we reported on the importance of the housing alignment. This month, we are reporting on other aspects of the housing.

The fact of the matter is that many of these housings are cracked. Usually the cracks are about 8" up from the bottom in the lowest of the 7/16" mounting holes on one or both sides.

So, why are so many of these cracked? This probably occurs from lateral pressure from the wishbone when a chuck hole, curb or other obstruction is hit. The wishbone fastens directly to the axle and to the bottom of the clutch housing which is bolted solidly to the flywheel housing. As the wishbone ball joint became worn it may have set up a jerking motion to amplify the problem. Also, as the rear motor mounts aged and the rubber became hard additional vibration may have been a factor.

Will there be a problem with running a cracked housing? Maybe not in the near term but as it worsens it could contribute to driveline misalignment and in extreme cases cause the transmission to jump out of gear.

It is not advisable to try to weld the housing because the heat is very likely to cause some warping which is a no, no for proper alignment.

The best option is to search for an un-cracked housing.

Not sure if the housing is cracked? Suspend the housing with one hand and tap the bottom of the housing with a hammer. If it is a solid housing you will hear a nice "ring". If the housing is cracked you will hear a "thud".

Sometime during the production of the Model A, the company became aware of this problem and produced an improved housing. The Judging Standards indicates that the improved housing appeared on cars sometime in 1931.

We have pictured the first, crack susceptible housing and the improved housing for your reference. The improved housing pictured is from a Diamond block (late production) engine although we have seen the improved unit on earlier production engines. If you are seeking a replacement the early style should be just fine with the mild conditions the car will be driven in a restored state. The improved housings are very hard to find.

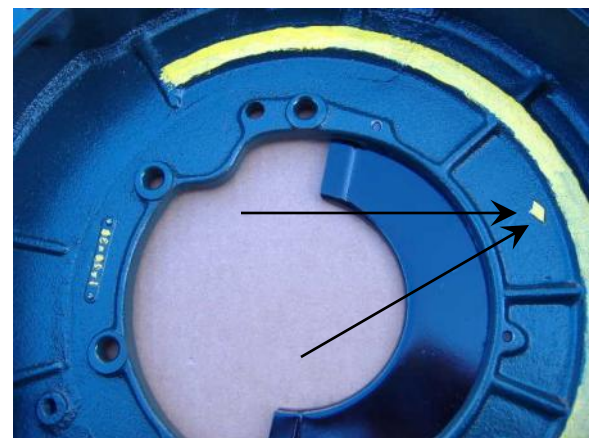

Larry & Mabel Oyer

Larry was born southwest of Dodge City. His father was the Pastor of the Baptist Church in Jetmore and worked on a farm. At the age of 4 **Larry** was stricken with Polio and was paralyzed from the waist down. The doctor's prognosis of **Larry's** ailment was grim but his mother found an Osteopath that was willing to work with him and after many trips for therapy the doctor was able to restore all of his movement except for some of his lower leg movement.

As the family moved around the area, **Larry** attended school in Dodge then Jetmore, Ness City and started high school in Gem which is near Colby in northern Kansas.

Larry's first car was a Model T, then another T that he drove back from Denver. Later he had a 31 Chevy, then a 33 Chevy and a 30 Chevy.

In his senior year Larry's father took a job at the First Baptist Church in Greensburg, consequently **Larry** graduated from Greensburg High in 1945.

At the time he graduated **Larry** had a really nice 36 Ford Coupe but he had to sell it in order to attend Ottawa University in Eastern Kansas.

He grew tired of riding a bicycle around campus so his dad found a farmer that had a 28 Model A Tudor "field car" for \$75. After a lot of cleaning and patching he drove the car to Ottawa.

Ending the second year of college, neither **Larry** nor his buddy had any goals or direction so they took off in the Model A to work their way to Alaska!!! They never made it past Dodge City.

While working around Dodge, **Larry** started to date **Mabel** whom he had known since child hood and in Aug of 49, they were married.

Larry took a correspondence course and got his teaching certificate.

A few years later the couple moved to Ottawa so **Larry** could complete his degree.

After his principal job in the Hillsdale School

for 3 years, the couple moved to Kansas City where **Larry** attended the Baptist Seminary.

With his education behind him **Larry** took Principal jobs in Stillwell, Larned, Lewis, Haviland and Moundridge. Then they moved to Wichita where **Larry** was the Pastor of Woodlawn Baptist Church for 28 Years.

In 1995 **Larry** joined the Wichita A's and started to think about the 31 Model A Coupe he had owned since 1967. Shortly after buying it in 67 **Larry** dismantled it, went to a lot of work to restore the chassis. Then it sat unfinished for almost 30 years. In the club he met **Gene** and **Bill Bosserman** whom he contracted to complete the body work, upholstery and paint. In a year or two it was complete and **Larry** drives it often. He also has a 26 Model T and a 53 Ford Victoria.

After retiring from Woodlawn Baptist Church, The **Oyers** moved to Newton and had plans to visit other churches so **Larry** could determine what he did wrong for the previous 28 years. (It appears to this writer that **Larry** did very little wrong in life.) Quite by accident he met a fellow who attended the Bethany Baptist Church near Bentley. That congregation had no permanent pastor and asked **Larry** if he would fill in the next day. He gladly accepted and is still there 12 years later, as the church continues to grow.

The **Oyers** have lived, taught and ministered at many places in Kansas and continue to be very active in their retirement. (Retirement??) Larry's early bout with Polio hasn't been any impairment at all. The couple has 4 daughters including a set of twins. RG

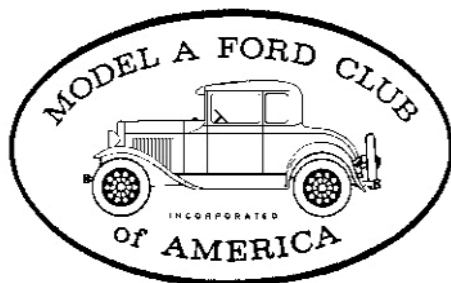
