# **TECH TALK**

## MODEL A HIGH COMPRESSION HEAD

Forty eight years ago I heard one of the charter members of the Wichita Club mention that he had a "Chrysler" head on his Model A, implying that it would run faster. I didn't ask questions or actually see the head but I was always curious how the name "Chrysler" fit in. Did Chrysler make a head for car made by their biggest competitor?

Over the years I heard the term a time or two but never actually saw one of these heads. Then last month, **Eric Weninger**, "The Medic", purchased a Chrysler head on e-bay and we were able to photograph it. It

does indeed have cast in the head, "Licensed by Chrysler Motors".

After extensive research on the Internet we learned that the combustion chamber in the head is of unique design and was patented by a British design engineer by the name of: Harry Ricardo. Apparently, Chrysler Motors paid Ricardo license fees to use the unique Ricardo combustion chamber in some of their engines. The manufacturer of the Model A head was actually Simmons, who had an agreement of some sort with Chrysler to use the Ricardo combustion chamber design. Maybe Chrysler had the exclu-

sive rights in the USA?

This head has a 6 to 1 compression ratio compared to 4.22 to 1 on the original engine. Snyder Antique Auto Parts currently offers a 5.5 to 1 head which seems to be ideal for improved performance without sacrificing engine life. The 6 to 1 ratio offers more performance but is not conducive to long engine life. It is more for the high performance "go fast" crowd.

Then there have been a few fellows who have adapted the 4 cylinder overhead valve setup from a 28 Chevy to a Model A. But that's another story for another time. RG




Unique combustion chambers, patented by Ricardo. 6 to 1 ratio.



## **ERA FASHIONS**

## Frocks that go to the smartest parties.



No. 6325. A crossed yoke heads a panel which is shaped to form a circular section providing fullness at the hem. Matching shorts accompany this frock.

No. 6327. The waistline of a frock is marked in front by a scalloped line and groups of shirrings, and in the back by a sash attached at the side seams.


No. 6328. The curve line in which the skirt is joined to the top is repeated in a shaped band that suggests a bolero. A belt marks the waistline.

No. 6323. One-sided lines are smartly adapted to small fashions in a frock with circular skirt attached in a line dipping at one side, and a diagonal neck-line

No 6324. A frock is slashed and shirred in front to suggest bloused lines and has a sash in the back. The circular skirt is joined on in a scalloped line.


