





NEW MEMBER PROFILE

BOB & SUE ROBARE

Bob and **Sue** are neighbors of **Charlie** and **Vinita Hawthorne**. **Bob** has always enjoyed working on cars but never had any exposure to a Model A Ford until he met the **Hawthornes**. **Bob** has a very well equipped shop with a lot of professional body equipment and a complete engine machine shop.

This summer **Bob** was visiting **Charlie** and **Marvin Hamlin** happened to be there. With **Bob** in mind **Charlie** asked **Marvin** if he knew of a Model A for sale. **Marvin** showed **Bob** his original 29 low mileage Tudor that he had bought from **Dennis Anderson**. In one of his weaker moments **Marvin** sold the car to **Bob**.

This Model A originated from **Dennis Anderson's** home town of Stromsburg, Nebraska. **Dennis** bought it from the **Walberg** brothers, a couple of elderly bachelors who were socially reserved. That was in 1969 and the car had something over 30,000 miles on it. **Dennis** sold it to **Marvin** in 2007, before it turned 40,000 miles.

Bob and **Sue** really appreciate this fine original example and want to preserve it however this brings on another issue, a tour car. They really don't want to drive the Tudor much, so they may buy another Model A for touring.

The **Robares** have had an interesting life. **Bob** was born and raised in upstate New York on a dairy farm. After earning an electrical engineering degree from Tri-State University in Indiana, Bob worked for McDonald on the Gemini Space Program. Next he worked for General Dynamics on the F111

and in Ft Worth, in 1969, he met and married **Sue**, a native of Big Spring, TX. They continued to move with each new assignment, San Diego then Rochester, NY.

With 2 young children, a boy and a girl they even went back to the dairy farm. With about a hundred head of cows this was a 24/7 occupation. After doing that for 3 1/2 years, they left the farm when **Bob** accepted a job with Rockwell in England. This turned into an eleven year stay and they made many life long friends while there.

In 1988 with teenage children they moved back to the USA in Clovis, NM for another Rockwell assignment. While living there **Bob** was sent to Desert Storm on a field assignment. In 1994 the couple found their way to Wichita with an offer from Rockwell Collins.
