Removing Your Oil Pan Splash Pan by Jim Zimmer

Here's a neat trick I picked up from the internet on how to easily remove the splash pan from your oil pan. All you need is a short length of 2x4, a wood clamp and a large screwdriver.

Place the 2x4 over your oil pan and using the clamp inserted under the oil pump opening and over the 2x4, tighten the clamp and just use the screwdriver to apply a little pressure under the splash pan at the rear of the pan and it popped right up!
